The Fredericksburg Fall Foliage Frolic is hosted by the Hill Country Bicycle Touring Club. SAG Support and Safety

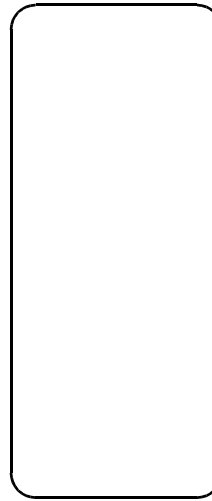

We cannot anticipate every road surface hazard or construction project you will encounter on this tour. You, the rider, are ultimately responsible for your own safety during your ride!! Use common sense and caution at all times.

The Hill Country Bicycle Touring Club is a recreational organization for cyclists of all abilities. Most of our rides are leader led where we stay together in groups. Maps may be available for riders who want to ride at their own pace. Each fall the club offers a century ride and several weekend tours. 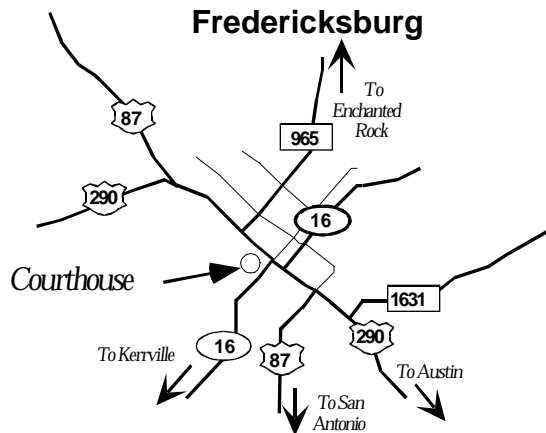


Registration

On site registration and packet pick up will be behind the courthouse at 8:00 AM. 25, 36 & 50 mile rides to Luckenbach and beyond leave there at 9:00 AM. After the ride join us for a "pot luck" picnic in Market Square across the street from the courthouse.

A German dinner at Friedhelm's Bavarian Inn, 905 W Main Street will be available Saturday night. The dinner includes generous portions of Jager Schnitzel, soup, salad, water, tax, and gratuity. Drinks, spirits, desserts extra.
