

Meeting Minutes: Saturday, June 14, 2008

Meeting called to order by **President Vern Jeys** at 5:55 p.m.

He asked that we please park our cars parallel to his truck when we get there. He also showed the club that he had a banner made with our logo and name on it. He will provide the coffee and donuts for the Saturday clean-up crew. There will be a 3 mile hike after if anyone is interested in going on that. Bob reminded everyone to wear good sturdy shoes and a hat with a brim on it to keep you protected from the sun.

Annie Boggs announced that she will be taking any orders for shirts, Tees, hats, purses, jackets etc. She can embroider our logo along with your name on anything you like.
